## INCOME DEDUCTIONS

Dependent Care Deduction-Households that qualify for dependent care deduction are allowed a deduction of actual dependent care costs paid monthly to a non-household member

Earned Income Deduction-Households with earned income are allowed a deduction of 20 percent of their earned income

Medicare Part B Medical Insurance and Part D Prescription Drug Coverage Premiums-Households that incur the cost of Medicare Part B medical insurance and/or Part D prescription drug coverage are allowed a deduction for the monthly cost of the premiums.

Child Support Deduction-Households that incur the cost of legally required child support to or for a nonhousehold member are allowed a deduction for the amount of monthly child support paid

\$450 deduction if you pay rent/mortgage payment or any utilities.
