The program provides for full time institutional training in any school providing a vocational (certificate, diploma or Associate of Applied Science) program. There are many great colleges that offer vocational technical training programs. Here are just a few areas of study available: Nail tech, Lineman, Nursing, Web Design, Welding tech and much more. However, there are some requirements. You must be enrolled as $\frac{1}{4}$ Indian in a Federally recognized Tribe, Live in the Trenton Indian Service Area at time of application and must show proof of having been accepted into school and have proof that you have applied for a Pell Grant.
