- You must be in the service area and you must have any required documents available to obtain services

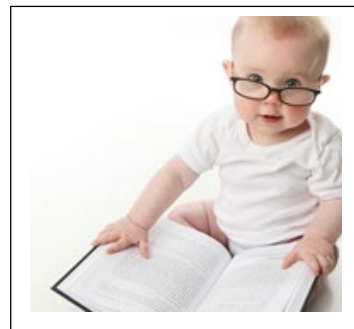
If you are wanting an eye exam, please call Casi at the clinic to verify you meet the requirements before calling Williston Basin at 701.577.3937.

## Optical Department

See if you or your child can get FREE glasses once a year:

- School age student until they are 19 years of age or tell the age of 22 if in college.
- Seniors who are 55+
  - This include frame and lenses

### Selection of frames

- Women's frames
- Men's frames
- Children's frames
- Sunglasses
- Safety frames

### Extras that everyone pays for.

- Transitions -\$80
- Tint – solid: \$8.40 / Gradient - \$11.10
- Scratch coat-\$13.97
- AR coat - \$49-\$86

Ask me about our supplies!

Cleaner spray (and refills) cloths, bands and repair kits.

\*Lenses varies from \$44.60 - \$275.80 depending on the type of lens.

\*Frames varies from \$35 - \$65

An appointment is not needed to pick out or pick up glasses; I do, however, encourage you call before coming out.
