

## **A-RROW Sanitation Driver (CDL) Job Summary**

The Driver is responsible for safely operating a collection truck, and providing prompt, courteous and complete waste removal services for residential and commercial customers throughout the Trenton Indian Service Area for A-RROW Sanitation Services. This position will be full-time, Monday – Thursday, 6:00 AM – 4:30 PM.

### **Responsibilities**

- Follow all required safety policies and procedures
- Safely operate heavy truck along designated routes and to disposal sites, read route sheets, follow maps, service customers as identified on the route sheet or as assigned by the Business Manager
- Ability to complete route(s) individually
- Perform routine inspection and maintenance on vehicles
- Ability to perform a physically demanding job, loading and unloading
- Operate hydraulic controls to lift/load in disposal of trash
- Courteously interacts with all customers and encourages customers to contact the Business Manager for any assistance
- Maintain all paperwork associated with compliance of state, federal, and DOT regulations
- Additional responsibilities may be assigned as appropriate, this summary is not considered to encompass all responsibilities

### **Physical Requirements**

- Must be able to sit/drive for long periods, up to 12 hours per day
- Must be able to lift up to 50lbs, overhead occasionally
- Frequent lifting, bending, twisting, sitting, driving, and standing
- Exposure to working outdoors in all weather conditions (hot, cold, dust, dirt, noise)

### **Qualifications**

- High school diploma and/or GED equivalent
- Possess a Class A or B CDL with an acceptable driving record; Class A CDL is highly preferred
- Waste removal experience preferred
- Must be mechanically inclined
- Ability to successfully pass all pre-employment requirements including a DOT physical, drug/alcohol test and background investigation
